

Phonics

This week, we will be focusing on the vowel patterns “aw,” “au,” “au(gh),” and “al.”

First, play the game provided (pdf). You will need a paper clip and a writing utensil for the spinner. You will also need a penny (or another small object of your choice) for your game piece. Then, follow the directions provided on the gameboard to play the game!

Next, on a piece of blank piece of paper (or the back of this one), write a short story using at least five of the words from the game. (You can use different “aw,” “au,” “au(gh),” and “al” words if you'd like.) Be sure to use capital letters at the beginning of your sentences and punctuation at the end of your sentences! It is also important you spell these vowel patterns correctly, so take your time!

Last, draw a picture (with labels) to match the events in your story! If you have coloring utensils, color in your illustration as well.
